Mandalay Bay Resort & Casino Information:

Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

AEDs used to treat sudden cardiac arrest are accessible by all trained security officers and emergency medical personnel.

Fire Extinguishers:

There are fire extinguishers and firefighting equipment mounted throughout Mandalay Bay.

First Aid Room:

Located on level 1 where emergency medical personnel are available to provide aid with minor first aid emergencies.

EVACUATION PROCEDURES

Follow the emergency evacuation directions given to you by Mandalay Bay Security Officers and staff. Proceed calmly to designated assembly areas where you will receive further instruction.

DESIGNATED ASSEMBLY AREAS

In the event of an evacuation, the attached map indicates the designated primary and secondary assembly areas for Convention Center guests. Mandalay Bay Security Officers will be in place to direct guests to the proper routes to reach these areas.

In case of emergency during convention hall hours -


ReMA Staff should gather just east (to the right of) the Shuttle Bus circle, near the primary assembly area.

In case of emergency after convention hall hours --

Follow Hotel emergency guidance to the safest evacuation point. When it is safe to do so, make your way to Mandalay Bay Road and meet where the road crosses under the Shoppes at Mandalay Place (between Mandalay Bay and Luxor)

Once you have safely exited the facility, check-in with **Garrison Lindsey** at the designated assembly area.

EMERGENCY SCENARIO

Exhibit Hall:

In the event an emergency occurs in the exhibit hall, contact the security from any house phone at 7-7911 or from an outside phone line call (702) 632-7911. Give your isle number and closest exhibitor. Explain as best you can, with a visual inspection, the nature of the emergency. Wait for security and EMT's to arrive and give your further instructions. While waiting, contact someone on the emergency response team and explain the situation, answering as many questions as you can.

Event Space

In the event an emergency occurs during a workshop or general session, contact the security from any house phone at 7-7911 or from an outside phone line call (702) 632-7911. Give the meeting room name and any other pertinent details. Explain as best you can, with a visual inspection, the nature of the emergency. Wait for security and EMT's to arrive and give your further instructions. While waiting, contact someone on the emergency response team and explain the situation, answering as many questions as you can.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

Mandalay Bay has a comprehensive Crisis/Emergency response plan that has been coordinated with local emergency response agencies and the local Fusion Center. The Crisis/Emergency Response Plan is confidential and is only released for “critical need” persons/agencies. The following information is the information we provide to our customers/clients:

All employees are trained routinely throughout the year in emergency response and evacuation of Mandalay Bay Property. Our emergency evacuation plans have been coordinated with local emergency response agencies and other emergency response authorities for optimal organizations during an event.

In the event of an incident involving property emergency response teams and external emergency response agencies, key employees are designated to participate in “Incident Command” and coordinate with local emergency response agencies and/or other agencies/authorities as necessary.

Upon incident assessment - requiring a partial or full evacuation, which may include client employee(s), Mandalay Bay Security staff as well as other key employees are well trained and familiarized with the evacuation process and will coordinate effectively with the client. Staging areas will be determined at the time of the incident in coordination with local emergency response agencies but we do provide pre-designated staging areas.

Public Announcement speakers are located throughout the property and specific directions during and after an incident will be relayed as necessary to ensure full communication to our vendors and guests minimizing chaos and/or confusion.

The nearest Level I Medical Center (Cardiac - Stroke - Critical Care) is approximately 7 miles from Mandalay Bay:

On-Site Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) emergency responders are posted throughout the property to ensure a rapid response time. If basic life support or cardiovascular life support is required while on our property, we recommend calling from a house phone 77911 or private phone 702-632-7911 versus 911 so to ensure the guest receives treatment quickly as possible.

Commonly and upon request we have a dedicated ACLS/BLS transport Unit assigned before, during, and post events.

Mandalay Bay has security team staffed 24/7 and are specially trained on safety and security of performances and events of all kinds. All Officers are trained and certified in Basic Life Support, First Aid, CPR/AED. Mandalay Bay Security typically is first on scene of an incident and Advanced Life Support is always requested and is provided by Local Fire Departments and/or Ambulance services. Mandalay Bay Security will perform additional services upon request. In addition, Mandalay Bay has an on-site K9 Unit with certified detection dogs who routinely sweep the property and can be contracted for your event if requested.

Only authorized personnel and vehicles are able to access the load in areas.

There are fire extinguishers and firefighting equipment mounted throughout Mandalay Bay and is maintained in accordance with Clark County Fire Department Fire Codes.

CONVENTIONS EMERGENCY CONTACT POSTER

This “Poster” (next page) provides Convention Clients and their related associates a quick reference for phone numbers to call in the event of an emergency.

Security Dispatch would always be the preferred first call for all emergency events. The other contact numbers are to be used for specific situational needs.

The Poster can be posted in work areas as well as can be distributed to Convention group leaders and/ or included in your group’s security team information packet.

It should be noted that the *directions on the bottom of the Poster in red*, if followed will ensure the best possible response time for first responders and emergency vehicle assistance.

ACTIVE SHOOTER INFO

COPING

WITH AN ACTIVE SHOOTER SITUATION

- Be aware of your environment and any possible dangers
- Take note of the two nearest exits in any facility you visit
- If you are in an office, stay there and secure the door
- Attempt to take the active shooter down as a last resort

Contact your building management or human resources department for more information and training on active shooter response in your workplace.

PROFILE

OF AN ACTIVE SHOOTER

An active shooter is an individual actively engaged in killing or attempting to kill people in a confined and populated area, typically through the use of firearms.

CHARACTERISTICS

OF AN ACTIVE SHOOTER SITUATION

- Victims are selected at random
- The event is unpredictable and evolves quickly
- Law enforcement is usually required to end an active shooter situation

HOW TO RESPOND

WHEN AN ACTIVE SHOOTER IS IN YOUR VICINITY

1. EVACUATE

- Have an escape route and plan in mind
- Leave your belongings behind
- Keep your hands visible

2. HIDE OUT

- Hide in an area out of the shooter's view
- Block entry to your hiding place and lock the doors
- Silence your cell phone and/or pager

3. TAKE ACTION

- As a last resort and only when your life is in imminent danger
- Attempt to incapacitate the shooter
- Act with physical aggression and throw items at the active shooter

CALL 911 WHEN IT IS SAFE TO DO SO

HOW TO RESPOND

WHEN LAW ENFORCEMENT ARRIVES

- Remain calm and follow instructions
- Put down any items in your hands (i.e., bags, jackets)
- Raise hands and spread fingers
- Keep hands visible at all times
- Avoid quick movements toward officers such as holding on to them for safety
- Avoid pointing, screaming or yelling
- Do not stop to ask officers for help or direction when evacuating

INFORMATION

YOU SHOULD PROVIDE TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OR 911 OPERATOR

- Location of the active shooter
- Number of shooters
- Physical description of shooters
- Number and type of weapons held by shooters
- Number of potential victims at the location
